
THE DANIEL FAST ~ 21-Day Experience With God ~

"I ate no pleasant food, no meat or wine came into my mouth, nor did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled." (Daniel 10:3 NKJV)

OVERVIEW OF THE DANIEL FAST

In the Old Testament book of Daniel, we can get great information regarding fasting. Both Daniel's physical and spiritual diets were an important part of his relationship with God. He ate carefully and lived prayerfully. While he limited his intake of food, Daniel indulged his prayer life. He put into practice his convictions, even when it put his life in danger.

The Daniel Fast is a partial fast that will lead to spiritual insight. Daniel and his friends ate only vegetables and drank only water (Daniel 1:8-12). Later, in Daniel chapter 10, Daniel fasted for three weeks (21 days). During this time of consecration, he abstained from choice foods and waited on God in prayer concerning the destiny of his people. The application of the Daniel Fast requires abstinence from certain foods. The most important point is to decide ahead of time how you are going to apply the Daniel Fast; then stick to your commitment for the length of time you have decided to fast. The Greater Sweethome Baptist Church family will fast for 21 days. You may even feel that it is good to make a permanent lifestyle change to the Daniel Fast.

7 - STEPS FOR THE DANIEL FAST

1) Be Specific

Daniel was not vague in his objection to the Babylonian diet. He defined the problem immediately.

- a. The king's food was against Old Testament dietary laws.
- b. Daniel and his friends had vowed against wine.
- c. The king's food had been offered up to idols/demons.

2) Fast as a Spiritual Commitment

The Daniel Fast involves a spiritual commitment to God. "Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself." (Daniel 1:8)

3) Reflect Inner Desire By Outer Discipline

Many people have a desire for better lives, health, marriage, finances, and etc. but they lack the discipline to achieve them.

4) Pray to Receive God's will For Your Life

Reference James 5:13-20 for both spiritual healing and physical health.

5) Fast as a Statement of Faith

Daniel was making a statement of faith when he asked for only vegetables to eat and water to drink. Then he dared the overseer to compare the appearance of the sons of Israel with the young men who ate the king's food. (Daniel 1:13)


6) Learn the Effects of the Food You Eat

Why are some foods good for us, and other foods not? What does certain foods do to your body?

7) Yield All Results to God

Daniel said, "As you see fit, deal with your servants." (Daniel 1:13)

FOODS TO EAT

All Whole Grains

All Fruits (Fresh, Frozen, Dried, Juiced, or Canned)

Apples, Apricots, Bananas, Blackberries, Blueberries, Boysenberries, Breadfruit, Cantaloupe, Cherries, Coconuts, Cranberries, Dates, Figs, Grapefruit, Grapes, Grenadine, Guava, Honeydew, Melons, Kiwi, Lemons, Limes, Mangoes, Mulberry, Nectarines, Oranges, Papayas, Peaches, Pears, Pineapples, Plums, Prunes, Raisins, Raspberries, Strawberries, Tangelos, Tangerines, Watermelon.

All Vegetables

Artichokes, Avocadoes, Asparagus, Beets, Broccoli, Brussels, Sprouts, Cabbage, Carrots, Cauliflower, Celery, Chili Peppers, Corn, Cucumbers, Eggplants, Garlic, Gingerroot, Kale, Leeks, Lettuce, Mushrooms, Mustard Greens, Olives, Okra, Onions, Parsley, any peppers, Potatoes, Radishes, Rutabagas, Scallions, Spinach, Sprouts, Squashes, Sweet Potatoes, Tomatoes, Turnips, Watercress, Yams, Zucchini.

All Seeds, Nuts, & Sprouts

All nuts & seeds, including almonds, cashews, macadamia nuts, peanuts, pecans, pine nuts, walnuts, pumpkin seeds, sesame seeds, and sunflower seeds. Unsweetened almond milk and nut butters are also included.

Liquids

Distilled, Filtered, and Spring Water, 100% All Natural Fruit Juices and Vegetable Juices, etc.

Limit **SALT** Intake

FOODS TO AVOID

Limit **DECAF COFFEE** Intake

Meat & Animal Products: beef, buffalo, fish, lamb, poultry, pork and sea food.

Dairy Products: butter, cheese, cream, eggs, and milk.

Solid Fats: lard, margarine, shortening, and high fat products.

Sweeteners: agave nectar, artificial sweeteners, sugar substitutes, high fructose corn syrup, cane juice, honey, molasses, raw sugar, syrups, stevia, and refined sugar.

Leavened Bread & Yeast: baked goods and Ezekiel bread (if it contains yeast and honey).

Refined & Processed Food Products: artificial flavorings, chemicals, food additives, preservatives, white rice, white flour, and pasta made with enriched white flour.


Deep-Fried Foods: corn chips, French fries, and potato chips.

Beverages: wine, alcohol, carbonated and caffeinated drinks, energy drinks, herbal tea, and tea.



Day 1 SPIRITUAL GROWTH - Commitment to the fast

Lord God, we fast and pray today in total thanksgiving. We give You thanks in all circumstances. Our hearts and minds are fixed on Jesus Christ who is pure, loving, kind, holy, and gentle. We will praise the Lord according to His righteousness: and will sing praise to the name of the Lord Most High. (Psalm 7:17) We will praise thee, O Lord, with our whole heart; we will shew forth all thy marvelous works. (Psalm 9:1) Father, we pray for strength and power from the Holy Spirit to sustain us in our commitment to this season of prayer and fasting. We will meditate on God's Word day and night. (Psalms 1:1-2) **AMEN!**

God's Prayer Promise: We have this confidence before God and receive from Him anything we ask, because we obey His commands and do what pleases Him. (1 John 3:21-22)

Day 2 SPIRITUAL GROWTH – To be disciples of Jesus Christ

Father God, as we fast and pray today, our desire is to be Your disciples. Help us to stay focused on Your will for us as Your ambassadors. You said in Your Word, ".....If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for My sake shall find it." (Matthew 16:24-25). Give us the discipline, self-control, and commitment to do what Paul told Timothy, "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." Day 4 HOLINESS AND PURIFICATION – Confession and Repentance

We fast with prayers of confession and repentance. I confess my sins today, Father God, and we ask for forgiveness. We desire to be holy as You are holy. Please cleanse us and restore us as we confess my sins. "Search me, O God and know my heart; try me and know my thoughts: And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting." (Psalm 139: 23-24) Renew and refresh us like you did David when he prayed, "Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me. Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit." (Psalm 51:10-12) Thank You for being faithful and just; for forgiving our sins; for purifying us from all unrighteousness. **AMEN!**

God's Prayer Promise: "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:9)

Day 5 HOLINESS AND PURIFICATION – Restoration and Renewal


Father, we rest in You today and give You praise, honor and glory. We fast and pray for restoration and renewal for this season of sanctification. Lord we offer to You our sacrifice of praise, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks. (Hebrews 13:15) Lord, we lift You up in worship. (Psalm 34:3) Since we have these promises, let us purify ourselves from everything that contaminates body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God. (Psalms 150:1) We will be imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us and gave Himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God. (Ephesians 5:1-2) We will present our bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is our reasonable service. We will not conformed to this world: but will be transformed by the renewing of our minds, that we may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. (Romans 12:1-2) **AMEN!**

God's Prayer Promise: "He has saved us and called us to a holy life—not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time." (2 Timothy 1:9)





Day 7 DIRECTION AND VISION – God-given Insight

Today we fast and focus on Your invincible Truth, Father God. We pray that Your presence will abide with us in a special way. We desire to have intimate fellowship with You. Touch our hearts in such a way that we will desire an even deeper fellowship with You and offer You our sacrifices of praise, worship and obedience. We plead for vision and discernment like Solomon. Give us wisdom and very great insight, and a breadth of understanding as measureless as the sand on the seashore. (1 Kings 4:29) **AMEN!**

God's Prayer Promise: "Wisdom and knowledge is granted unto thee; and I will give thee riches, and wealth, and honour, such as none of the kings have had that have been before thee, neither shall there any after thee have the like." (2 Chronicles 1:12)

Day 8 DIRECTION AND VISION – Divine Guidance

Father, today we fast and pray, seeking Your guidance and blessing for our personal needs. Lord God, we know that Your Word is true; that You will supply all of our needs according to Your riches in glory. (Philippians 4:19) Help us to stand in faith and to seek Your Kingdom and Your righteousness so that all we need can be added to us. (Matthew 6:33). We thank You in advance for all of Your provisions and for every blessing, those seen and especially those not seen, as we walk by faith and not by sight. We realize today that "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning." (James 1:17) **AMEN!**

God's Prayer Promise: "Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation of things. 21 For prophecy never had its origin in the human will, but prophets, though human, spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit." (2 Peter 1:20-21)

Day 9 DIRECTION AND VISION – Revelation

We fast with prayers of worship and thanksgiving. We seek your divine guidance as a stranger traveling thorough a barren land. You said in Your Word, "Call unto Me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not." (Jeremiah 33:3) Therefore, we put our hope and trust in You, knowing that You have already made provisions for us. Our souls magnify the Lord in our songs, in our prayers, in our giving, and in our study. We stand in awe of Your greatness and power. We long for Your presence. "I spread out my hands to You; my soul thirsts for You like a parched land." (Psalm 143:6) I glorify Your name for You have done great things. **AMEN!**

God's Prayer Promise: "But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you." (John 14:26)





Day 10 OUR FAMILIES – Marriages

God's Prayer Promise: "And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding." (Jeremiah 3:15)


Day 15 OUR CHURCH – Ministries

Day 17 SPECIAL NEEDS – Breakthrough and Deliverance



ISAIAH 58:1-14
